NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing.2009-2012*
- 1.2 The Yachting New Zealand prescription relating to rule 68 – Damages shall apply:
 1. *The findings of fact, and decisions of protest committees, shall be relevant only for the purposes of the ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing.*
 2. *All claims for damages arising from breaches of any of these rules are matters for other jurisdictions.*
 3. *A boat that retires from a race, or accepts a penalty, does not, by that action alone, admit liability*
- 1.3 If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.

2 ADVERTISING & IDENTIFICATION

- 2.1 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organising authority on their hull and/or their boom in accordance with regulation 20.3(d). The organizing authority will supply the stickers and instructions for their use.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to all competitors of the Splash class complying with SCIA class rule C2.
- 3.2 To be eligible to compete in this event each competitor shall be a financial member of a club recognised by the competitor's national authority.
- 3.3 To be eligible to compete in this event each competitor shall be a financial member of his or her National Splash Class Association or SCIA (if a National Class Association does not exist).
- 3.4 Eligible competitors may enter by completing the attached entry form and submitting it by 13th December, 2009 to:

- 3.5 Late entries, accompanied by an additional late entry fee of \$30.00 may be accepted up to the time of registration at the discretion of the Organising Authority.

4 CLASSIFICATION

There are no classification requirements in accordance with RRS 79

5 FEES

5.1 Entry fees are \$90.00 per boat.

5.2 Fees must be paid before 13th December, 2009:

6. ON-SITE REGISTRATION

6.1 Competitors shall complete the on-site registration and at the race office at the venue as scheduled.

6.2 Each competitor shall produce at registration the following official documents:
A valid membership card to his/her MNA or sailing licence if any.
A valid membership card to his/her NCA if applicable.
An Advertising Licence Card of his/her MNA if applicable.
The Entry Confirmation.
Proof of payment.

7 SERIES FORMAT:

The series will be sailed as a single fleet. There will be no qualifying or final series.

8 SCHEDULE

8.1 Registration: Sat 19th December, 0800 – 1000hrs

8.2 Race Schedule:

Day	Date	Racing	Time of first warning signal
Saturday	19 th Dec	Up to 3 Races	1100 hours
Sunday	20 th Dec	Up to 3 Races	1100 hours
Monday	21 st Dec	Up to 3 Races	1100 hours

8.3 A maximum of 9 races will be sailed.

8.4 On Monday 21st December no warning signal will be made after 1600hrs.

9 MEASUREMENT

9.1 Each boat shall produce a valid measurement certificate.

9.2 Boats and their rigs may be checked at random at any time during the Regatta.

10 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will be available at registration in the Takapuna Boating Club.

11 RACING AREA

11.1 The shore location will be the premises of Takapuna Boating Club

11.2 Races will be sailed on the inner Hauraki Gulf off Takapuna Beach.

12 THE COURSES

The courses to be sailed will be trapezoid with a gate at the leeward mark(s) as described in the Sailing Instructions.

13 PENALTY SYSTEM

13.1 Appendix P may apply.

13.2 P2.1 First Protest: Add after the first sentence: "or, if protested when she is no longer racing by accepting a scoring penalty of 6 points."

13.3 For protests where only a Rule of Part 2 is alleged to have been broken an arbitration hearing will be offered prior to any formal hearing.

14 SCORING

14.1 The low-point scoring system appendix A of RRS will apply.

14.2 9 races are scheduled of which 3 shall be completed to constitute a Series.

14.3 The discard system will be described in the Sailing Instructions.

15 SUPPORT BOATS

15.1 Support personnel, team leaders and coaches shall complete on-site registration at the race office at Registration.

15.2 Sufficient Personal Flotation Devices for each crew member must be carried by all support boats at all times in accordance with New Zealand Maritime Law.

15.3 Team leaders, coaches, and other support personnel shall comply with NOR 16.

16. PROHIBITED ANCHORING AREA:

16.1 All boats associated with the championship and including support boats shall comply with the New Zealand Government Regulation "Submarine Cables and Pipelines Protection Act 1996". This regulation prohibits anchoring in the area shaded in the No Anchoring area in Appendix 2 and defined on charts NZ532 and NZ5322.

16.2 Any boat or support craft breaking NOR 16.1 will be subject to a hearing resulting in a report to their National Authority and ISAF. As a consequence, the competitor(s) associated with the support craft may be disqualified from the race closest to the time of the infringement.

17 BERTHING / LAUNCHING & RETRIEVAL

17.1 Unless otherwise directed by the Organising Authority, all competing boats and equipment shall be launched and retrieved on the designated areas on the Beach Front Reserve at Takapuna Beach near the Takapuna Boating Club.

18 RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

19 PHOTOGRAPHY CONSENT

By entering the Championships competitors accept that they may be photographed and/or videotaped participating in the race and/or using the regatta facilities and they consent to the taking of such images and to the use, reuse, publication and republication of such images in any media, in conjunction with the competitor's name or not, without compensation and without the competitor's approval of such images or any use thereof.

20 PRIZES

20.1 The first three places shall be recognised.

20.2 Spot prizes may be awarded

21 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The Organizing Authority and all parties involved in the regatta organisation will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

22 INSURANCE

22.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover, including coverage when racing off Takapuna Beach of NZD \$5,000,000 (or the equivalent)

22.2 Proof of this insurance, including racing cover, shall be available at all times.
