KERIKERI CRUISING CLUB SPRING REGATTA is open to classes of Centreboard yachts. Organised and Hosted by the KERIKERI CRUISING CLUB. the Regatta will be sailed from DOVES BAY in the waters of TE PUNA INLET on Saturday 28th & Sunday 29th November. 2009

1.0 RULES

- 1.1 The Regatta will be governed by the 2009- 2012 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)**
- 1.2 All boats must comply with their class rules.**
- 1.3 The Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations Part 1 shall apply.**

2.0 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRIES

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all sailors in Mistral, Splash, Laser, Laser Radial, Optimist, Optimist Green and A Class Catamaran.**
- 2.2 Competitors must be a member of a Yacht Club Affiliated to YNZ.**
- 2.3 Entry fee for the two days is \$30 per competitor, and if more than one in a family \$25**
- 2.4 Registration is on the day but pre-registration would be appreciated to assist in organisation.**

3.0 SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

12.00 Briefing

1.00 pm Warning signal for race 1 with 4 races back to back for each class

Sunday from :

10.30 am Warning signal for race 1 with 4 races back to back for each class

4.0 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

4.1 Sailing Instructions will be available to view at registration

5.0 RACING AREA

5.1 The races will be held in the Te Puna Inlet

6.0 COURSES TO BE SAILED

6.1 The course will be trapezoidal

7.0 SCORING

7.1 Boats will be scored for their place within their own class, not the fleet they have started in.

7.2 Six races, five to count, eight races, six to count

7.3 The LowPoints Scoring System of Appendix A will apply

8.0 PRIZEGIVING

8.1 Prizes will be awarded to the first three places within each class (not fleet)

8.2 Prizes and Spot prizes will be presented as soon as possible after completion of the last race on day 2.

9.0 BBQ

9.1 A sausage and drink will be provided to each competitor after completion of the last race on day 1 and last race on day 2
